Payment Terms

- Full payment must be made prior to the charter start.

Damage and Loss

- Charterer Responsibility: The charterer is responsible for any damage to the boat or equipment caused by negligence or misuse.

Liability

- Charter Company Liability: The charter company is not liable for any personal injury or property damage suffered by the charterer or their guests.
- Charterer Liability: The charterer is responsible for the actions of their guests and any damage or injury they may cause.

Force Majeure

- Definition: Force majeure events include acts of God, war, terrorism, natural disasters, or other events beyond the control of either party.
